

Street Names (17) included in Original Plat of the Village of Rhineland (Recorded Oct. 10, 1882 – Lincoln County)

July 1882 AW & WE Brown met with agents of MLS&W RR to lay out the Village

Alban (Stephen Harris Alban was friend & relative of the Brown Family, also a lawyer, judge, and for seven years, Postmaster in Rhineland. He was in charge of recording the land sales in the early days)

Anderson (T.W. Anderson - E.D. Brown's Brother In Law (one of four original investors in land))

Brown (Founding family name - specifically for Anderson W. and Webster E.)

Davenport (F.W. Rhineland's Mother-In-Law's Maiden Name)

Edgar (Married name of sister (Eliza) of F.W. Rhineland (Brother in law -Commodore Wm Edgar))

Frederick (Frederick W. Rhineland Village name sake – President of the Milwaukee, Lake Shore & Western RR)

Harvey (H.G.H (Harvey) Reed – Superintendent for Milwaukee Lake Shore & Western Railroad)

King (Married name of daughter of F.W. Rhineland)

Messer ?

Pelham (New York township with which the Rhineland family had a long history)

Phillip (son of F.W. Rhineland)

Rives (Married name of daughter of F.W. Rhineland)

Stevens (F.W. Rhineland's Mother's Maiden Name)

Thayer (John O. Thayer – land Agent for Milwaukee Lake Shore & Western Railroad)

Young (George A. Young – surveyor of the original plat)

Abner & Conro (Abner Conro came to Rhineland in 1882 to build a Sawmill)
